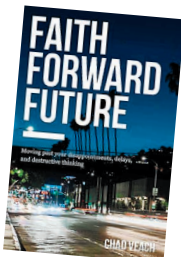

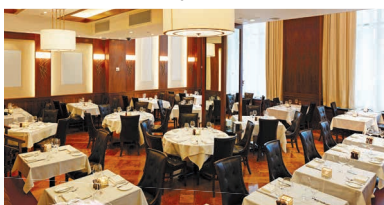

Pan's Labyrinth and *Hellboy* director **Guillermo del Toro** does *Splash* meets *E.T.* Huzzah! In 1962 Baltimore, during the height of Cold War paranoia, a mute woman (**Sally Hawkins**) working as a janitor in a government facility becomes attached to a captured,

otherworldly water creature. A mustache-twirling agent (**Michael Shannon**, obviously) wants to kill it; she believes this outsider is her soul mate. At times, the fantastical fairy tale nearly drowns in its own quirkiness — fish sex and tap dancing, anyone? But the connection between beauty and beast is simply magical. See it more than once to believe it. MR

JUSTIN'S EMOTIONAL ROLLER COASTER

For the holidays, the cast of NBC's *This Is Us* present each other a reason to cry — happy tears. Together, "we go and get everyone a gift," explains **Justin Hartley**, whose character Kevin struggles with a painkiller addiction on the Emmy-winning drama (Tuesdays, 9 P.M.). "We have a lot to celebrate." The 40-year-old, wed to **Chrishell Stause**, shares more. **Q: Hardest story line?** The thing about our show is none of it is easy. But right

now, Kevin's. Trying to tackle that alone is a recipe for disaster. We show the real, dangerous place he's in. It's somewhere people go. To me, that's impactful. **Q: How do you lighten the mood in between takes?** What keeps us going is a laugh. **Milo [Ventimiglia]** and **Sterling [K. Brown]** make me laugh all day. They are two of my best friends. **Q: Most likely to carry a tissue box around set?** **Chrissy [Metz]**! She's really in touch with her emotions and we love that about her.

ABC's chief meteorologist shows Us how she gets it all done — rain or shine



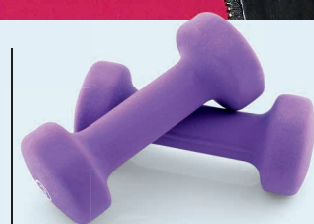
8:00 A.M. CHILL IN THE AIR

With her son, Zee takes a 45-minute nap. "Being pregnant, my energy level is so different." Feeling recharged, she has an hour-long workout with trainer **Mark Langowski**. "We used weighted ropes. I was dying!" Next, she catches up with TV host husband **Ben Aaron**.



4:15 P.M. DUTY CALLS

Though set to attend *Glamour's* Women of the Year Awards, she cancels for *World News Tonight*. Before the broadcast, Zee checks the computer forecast. "I look for facts and figures and get into the science, which I love."



7:30 P.M. WRAP UP

Home for bedtime! She and Aaron read their tot three books, including *Goodnight Moon*. When he falls asleep, they cheer for **Val Chmerkovskiy** on *DWTS*. Finally, at 9:20, she's off to sleep. "And that's a slow day!"
